CANSKATE

- Season runs from Sep 13 to Mar 14

Learn-to-Skate ("CanSkate")

- For those 3 years and up as of Dec 31, 2025
- Teen/Adult group available on Mondays for those 12 years and up
- Focus is on basic skating skills to complete Skate Canada CanSkate Badges 1 to 6
- Good for hockey, ringette and figure skating
- Includes a 10-minute warm-up, two 15-minute group lessons and a 5-minute cool-down

Intro to Figure Skating ("Intro")

- Must have passed CanSkate Badge 3, or at coach's discretion
- An advanced CanSkate program for skaters interested in pursuing figure skating
- Focus is on skating elements like spins, jumps, edges and turns while completing CanSkate Badges 4 to 6
- A two-day program that includes group lessons with the option to arrange a private lesson during the session with another Club coach for an additional fee

STARSKATE

- Season runs from Sep 2 to Mar 29
- Offers development in fundamental figure skating skills in the areas of ice dance, skating skills, freeskate and artistic skating
- Skaters are evaluated through Skate Canada's nationally standardized testing system from Star 1 to 10 plus Gold as well as Diamond Dance
- Requires arrangement of lessons (private, semi-private and/or group) with a Club coach (these fees are not included in registration fees but instead are billed directly by the coaches)
- A current listing of Club coaches can be found on our website

Junior

- Passed CanSkate Badge 6, or at coach's discretion

Intermediate

- Passed Star 2 Freeskate, or at coach's discretion

Senior

- Passed Star 4 or 5 Freeskate, or at coach's discretion

* Registration is open until January 31, 2026, but some sessions fill quickly. Register early to get your preferred sessions!

CLUB RULES

- CSA-approved hockey helmet and gloves/mittens must be worn by all CanSkate participants up to and including Stage 5. Bicycle or other sport helmets are not allowed.
- Skaters under the age of 12 must have a parent or guardian in the arena at all times during sessions.
- Skaters are to use assigned dressing rooms for putting on/taking off skates
- Parents and/or unregistered skaters are not permitted on the ice during sessions
- There are no make-up days due to illness, vacations, or conflicting events
- Please contact coaches off the ice, not during group or private lessons
- The number of skaters allowed at one time on all sessions shall be limited
- The Club reserves the right to adjust, cancel, or reschedule sessions should it be deemed necessary
- Refund requests will only be considered for medical or exceptional reasons and must be made in writing along with supporting documents. The Board reserves the right to deny refunds.
- The Skate Canada/Admin Fee is non-refundable or transferrable. Additional administrative fees may also apply to cancelled memberships.
